#### What can you do to make a difference?

Offices in the United States use 12.1 trillion sheets of paper per year.<sup>1</sup> Using paper can have negative impacts on the environment if thrown into the trash, contributing to landfill volume. Paper can take up to 26% of landfill space.<sup>1</sup> So, how do you keep your discarded paper out of the landfill in a way that helps keep your company's confidential data safe? Use a secure document destruction service that aims to recycle all shredded paper, like Shred-it<sup>®</sup>. In 2022 Shred-it<sup>®</sup> recycled approximately 1 billion pounds of paper, which is the equivalent of the amount of paper that could be harvested from approximately 9 million trees.

### What is a shred-it-all policy?

Implementing a shred-it-all policy can help ensure your employees throw confidential papers into a secure console for shredding versus a recycling bin. This policy encourages the regular destruction of all documents to help ensure no confidential information is left in the open that could fall into the wrong hands while at the same time recycling the paper.
